



2026 USCA Stock Aluminum Nationals

July 10th, 2026 at Calico Rock, Arkansas

On July 10th, the USCA Stock Aluminum Nationals will be held in Calico Rock, Arkansas. The event will take place in conjunction with the 60th Annual White River Canoe and Kayak Race, a beloved tradition in the region.

The Stock Aluminum Nationals will be divided into two legs, each offering its own unique challenges and scenic beauty. The first leg will cover a distance of 18 miles, starting in Norfolk, AR, and ending in Calico Rock, AR. This leg is open to Mens, Women, and Junior classes, allowing paddlers of all ages and skill levels to participate.

The second leg of the race will be a 17-mile stretch from Calico, AR, to Allison, AR. This leg is reserved for the Mix class, where teams consisting of both male and female paddlers will compete against each other.

Both legs of the race will take place on the scenic White River, known for its crystal-clear waters, diverse wildlife, and breathtaking Ozark Mountain scenery. The USCA Stock Aluminum Nationals is a prestigious event in the canoe racing community, attracting top paddlers from across the country. Competitors will battle for medals and national titles in their respective classes, showcasing their skills and endurance on the challenging White River course.

The 60th Annual White River Canoe and Kayak Race and the USCA Stock Aluminum Nationals promise to be an unforgettable experience for participants and spectators alike. Whether you're a seasoned paddler or simply looking for a fun and adventurous day outdoors, this event has something for everyone.

Stock Aluminum:

1. Standard type aluminum canoes only. Up to and including the 2001 Aluminum Nationals, maximum length is 18 feet 6 inches. After the 2001 Aluminum Nationals, maximum length is 17 feet 4 inches.
2. The intention of the stock aluminum class is to have a National Championship class for stock factory aluminum canoes. Internal modifications are permitted that don't affect the outside dimensions.
3. The specifications of a stock canoe have been purposely left off and the canoes will be judged "stock" by the Competition Chairman and the Technical Director of Inspection. Most common manufacturers of aluminum boats will meet this requirement. Approval may be obtained for a specific model at the Nationals jiggging.
4. No modifications can be made to the exterior of the canoe, or internally that will affect the hull shape of the canoe. Modifications to seats, interior bulkheads or endcaps, and footbraces are allowed. To facilitate a change of seat type and placement, original factory seats may be removed. Sufficient flotation must be permanently affixed to the canoe to support a 25 pound weight when boat is full of water.

Attendance at pre-race meetings is mandatory. A U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD must be in the possession of each paddler, and one whistle per boat, or a time penalty will be assessed to course time.
